Dear Parent/Carer,

Can I thank all students, families and staff for their response to the most recent government guidance in managing safe working practices within school regarding COVID-19. As always students have been extremely responsible and ensured that they have followed all requests to help keep themselves and others safe.

As we approach the last two weeks of term, we will continue to follow government guidance and take any required action in response to national developments.

What we do know at this stage, is that following our last day of term on Friday, 17<sup>th</sup> December, all students will have been provided with home testing kits which can be used over the Christmas and New Year period to regularly test. We know that families will be keeping a watchful eye on information from central government to ensure that any updated guidance is followed.

All schools have been asked to ensure that all students undertake Lateral Flow Testing on their return to school on Wednesday, 5<sup>th</sup> January. We anticipate, as was the case on our return in September, most families will undertake their test at home on the evening before their return. A reminder that if a positive result is returned then the individual must self-isolate and book a PCR immediately.
