Benefits	How skills, attributes and values benefit individuals when receiving care: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Be supported to overcome their own person obstacles ○ Receive high quality care ○ Receive person-centred care based on individual wishes ○ Be treated with respect ○ Not be discriminated against ○ Be empowered and have independence ○ Be involved in care decisions ○ Be protected from harm ○ Feel comfortable to raise complaints
