Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Last Day Arrangements for Year 11 – Friday, 23 May 2025

Can I congratulate our Year 11 for making such a positive start to their examinations. All staff, including the invigilators, have commented on how impressed they are with their conduct. It is important that students continue to remain focused and effectively use time at home (including over the half term holiday period).

Friday, 23 May marks the last formal day in school for Year 11 students prior to flexible study; following the half term break students have the flexibility to work in school or at home. A reminder of several of the key points previously communicated are given below.

Following half term, students can undertake revision at home during the school day. When they have an exam, they must arrive 20 mins prior to the exam.

- 9:00am start 8:40am in West Hall
- 1:00pm start 12:40pm in West Hall
- 1:30pm start 1:10pm in West Hall

Outside of examinations, students are expected to either be in school or revising at home. Lessons will continue to run for all subjects until examinations in that subject area have been completed. We strongly encourage students to continue to attend sessions in school, although know that many will benefit from individual study time at home. Students have been provided with an overview which shows all examinations, lessons and additional revision sessions that will be available. (Click <u>HERE</u> for timetable)

Students should not be in town or hanging around outside school grounds if they are leaving school site. It is expected that students are either at home revising or accessing revision in school. Should students be found in breach of this requirement then their right to flexible study will be withdrawn.

When attending examinations, students will be signed in, in the exam hall and will be classed as signed out at the end of the exam. If students are onsite at any other time they are required to SIGN IN and SIGN OUT of school when arriving or leaving the site at <u>West Reception</u>.

On Friday, 23 May we will be signing off the half term with our usual activities to mark the students' last formal day in school and will be allowing students an early finish at **1:00pm**, at which point students will be able to return home. The format for the day will be as follows:

- **Registration and Period 1/2** Normal form time and lesson (unless involved with formal exams).
- Extended Break Refreshments will be provided during break time in East Hall.
