Re: Year 11 Final Summer Examinations

Please find attached a copy of the [exam and revision timetable](#) for Year 11 as we approach the end of their time with us at Oldbury Wells School.

It indicates all exams (green), additional pre-exam revision sessions (yellow) along with some online revision opportunities (orange). All revision sessions will take place in the West Hall unless otherwise stated.

For some exams before half term, pupils will require an early lunch, starting at 12.30pm. This is also indicated on the sheet in red. This early lunch must be taken in the West Hall, where pupils must remain until called through for their exam.

A reminder on some already shared key points:

Morning examinations start at 9:00am, all learners involved in the exam are expected to be in the West Hall by 8:40am to receive any final instructions. Afternoon examinations start at either 1:00pm or 1:15pm. All students involved have the opportunity to take an early lunch.

Exam preparation. Students have been recipients of our 'revision revolution' program, designed to build their understanding of various exam preparation strategies e.g. the importance of effective revision timetables, interleaving, Cornell Notes, self-quizzing and the effective use of flashcards. They have also completed three mock examination series across Year 10 and Year 11. Given this broad experience, it is essential that all students apply their understanding of exam expectations by following instructions and listening carefully to information given prior to any examination. Students are required to attend all examinations and any in-school sessions in full school uniform and with the required equipment for each session.

Looking forward, GCSE results day is on Thursday, 20 August 2026; further details regarding this will be sent out in due course.

I would like to take this opportunity to wish all students good luck in the weeks ahead knowing that their dedication, effort, organisation and resilience will lead to excellence.
