Re: Home Testing for All Students

We have today completed all our in-school student testing and I am sure, like me, you would like to thank all the volunteers and the whole testing team for the absolutely amazing job that they have done. The students themselves have also been a credit to the school with their positive attitude towards the testing.

We have completed nearly 2,200 tests over the 2-week testing period, so a huge well done to all the team.



As we are now moving to the next phase of testing, and further to our letter on Wednesday, can I remind parents that all students will be given their Home Testing Kits to bring home tomorrow, (Friday, 19th March) and we will be starting to roll out our Home Testing Program of twice weekly testing.

We are asking students to do their first home test this **Sunday, 21st March** and thereafter every Thursday and Sunday evening. Testing twice a week at home should also continue throughout the Easter holidays and additional kits to cover this period will be sent home next Friday, 26th March.
