Transition Summer School 2021

The purpose of the Oldbury Wells Transition Summer School was to draw on the national summer schools funding programme to provide transition support, academic catch-up and enrichment to the Year 7 cohort of students joining Oldbury Wells in September 2021.

Eligibility for Summer School Places

The OWS Transition Summer School was available to all students who had reached the end of their primary education phase and were due to start at Oldbury Wells in September 2021. The offer of a fully funded place was made to the parents of all eligible students in writing. The fully funded provision was offered to all students irrespective of their academic and socio-economic background.

Summer School Funding

The OWS Transition Summer School is funded through the ESFA/DfE Coronavirus (COVID-19) Summer School Programme Funding.

Summer School Programme

The OWS Transition Summer School was a weeklong provision, taking place between 26th July 2021 and 30th July 2021 inclusive. The programme was staffed by Oldbury Wells Teaching/Support Staff and a small number of external providers. The programme was designed to offer a balance of academic sessions (English, Maths, Science and Computing) and those that offer enrichment and team building opportunities for our students. Students received three taught sessions per day, each lasting 1.5hrs.
